- Tubers Academy was founded by Nick Ellison, who came from a background in social media training, website design and commercial video production.
- Tubers is a creative space and video creator's academy for young people with interests in media, video games and technology.
- 7-10 year olds are taught through experiential learning, getting hands on experience with camera equipment and virtual reality technology.
- 11-18 year olds work through a structured digital media curriculum taught by Academy Mentors, covering video production, audio equipment, lighting, gaming live streaming, online safeguarding and more.
- The first Tubers Academy opened on February 6th 2017 in Exeter, England.
- Tubers Academy has been featured by global news and television outlets including BBC World News, The Times, Le Monde, The Mirror and more.
- We have around 200 members who attend training sessions on a weekly basis.
- We've had young people attend our training courses from all over Europe, travelling from even as far as Switzerland!
